KEY INFO – JUNIOR SCIENCE OLYMPIAD EXAM			
Exam length	2 hours plus 11 minutes self-registration time. The exam will time out when time is up.		
Format	Online exam consisting of 48 multiple choice/select an answer questions. Normal exam supervision and conditions apply.		
Exam dates	Wednesday 14 June = for Year 9 & 10 students		
	Friday 16 June = for Year 7 & 8 students		
	All students from the same cohort must sit the exam <u>at the same time</u> on the same day, unless prior arrangements have been made.		
	Alternate sitting dates are available and must be requested before 14 June 2023. See <u>Alternate Sitting Date Form</u>		
Exam Times	The exam will be open and accessible between 7am and 6pm (AEST).		
Access Details On Friday 9 June 2023	<b>Students</b> will receive an email to the address provided during the registration. This email will contain the test site URL and instructions on how to access the exam.		
	<b>Teachers</b> will receive the Teacher Guide and credentials to access the exam familiarisation link. You will be required to change the password to something your team will remember.		
	<b>NOTE:</b> There is no teacher dashboard. You will not be able to see the exam or any student data. There is no paper version available.		
	You can securely share the Teacher Guide and login details with each supervising teacher.

#### **BEFORE EXAM DAY - TEACHERS**

The registering teachers should log into the exam site using the access details provided by email and:

  - o share this username and password details with all supervising teachers
  - o share this Teacher Guide with all supervising details

ALL supervising teachers should:

- 2. log into the exam site and complete the Site Familiarisation (Image 2)
- 3. ensure their device allows access to the exam site

NOTE: You will be seeing what the students see. There is no teacher dashboard. You will not be able to see the exam or any student data. There is no paper version available.


#### **BEFORE EXAM DAY – STUDENTS**

- 3. ensure their device allows access to the exam site


The Junior Science Olympiad Exam will NOT be visible until the exam opens.

#### **IMPORTANT**

Students should NOT enter the Junior Science Olympiad Exam before their sitting time.

The exam you are registered for will appear on the scheduled day. Ensure students DO NOT access the exam before you are ready to run the exam. Students only have **ONE** attempt at the exam. It can not be re-set.




- Harder and easier questions are intermixed in the exam.
